Fluor's Receives Workplace Volunteer Recognition from S.C. Governor's Office

Columbia, SC – The Greenville based office of **Fluor Corporation** was honored today as the 2010 Governor's Award Workplace Agency recipient. The award ceremony took place at the State Capital followed by a luncheon in the Governor's Mansion in Columbia. Executives from Fluor Corporation, as well as **Meals on Wheels of Greenville County**, who nominated the company, were in attendance.

Sponsored by the Office of the Governor, the South Carolina Association for Volunteer Administration (SCAVA,) and United Way Association of South Carolina's Commission on National and Community Services each year the Governor's Volunteer Awards recognize the contributions made by special volunteers or volunteer groups in South Carolina. A diverse committee of professional volunteer administrators representing public and private agencies and organizations throughout the state selected this year's recipients. The committee was charged with selecting volunteers in eight categories from a large pool of applicants. The Workplace Agency Award is given to a corporation, business or trade association that has demonstrated commitment to the community by supporting volunteer activities.

In 2009, 334 Fluor employees volunteered for Meals on Wheels of Greenville County. Each week 20 routes are delivered by Fluor employees, averaging about 242 meals that are provided to homebound individuals throughout Greenville County. In addition to their involvement in Meals on Wheels, Fluor is consistently a leader in the United Way Annual Fund. Fluor employees also volunteer for organizations such as Habitat for Humanity, Backpack for Basics, Hands on Greenville, Golf for Greenville and numerous other organizations. In 2009, 1,245 of its 2,700 Upstate employees volunteered 13,554 hours on community projects.
